

## Minutes of NDP Meeting on Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> January 2016

### 7.30pm at Harbury Club

The purpose of this meeting was to receive feedback from the 'informal consultation' and make amendments as necessary.

The Consultation Drafts were handed out so the group could look at the comments in relation to the printed document. Three pages of 'comments' were distributed. There were four written responses to the Plan left at the Library and these were read out. There had been verbal responses, and discussions in pubs, but these were not recorded.

Photographs in the Plan: A Community Consultation photo had been added by Michael and a different Eco-house photo used. The Village Hall photo still needs updating.

#### DISCUSSED:

- 1) Linda's comments emailed before the end of the informal consultation.
- 2) Bob's comments regarding Objective 6 and H.14 received on 29<sup>th</sup> December.
- 3) Paul's comments received on 25<sup>th</sup> January.

Many of Linda's ideas were used as she had examined the Plan and emailed Michael. The phrase **Lack of adequate parking provision** was added to 3.31 and the **War Memorial** was moved from Community Assets to Protecting Local Heritage. Much discussion took place over her 'Local Green and Open Spaces Analysis' and some changes made to wording. The Pound needs to be highlighted on Table 1, page 40.

It was felt that Bob's update on Sustainable Design and Energy Efficiency made some good points. He explained that statements *a – f* should replace *a – c* in Policy H.14 and this was agreed. A reference to the Parish Council was added to *a*. (inform Michael)

Paul had not attended a NDP meeting since March but all his comments on walking, cycling, transport and the conservation areas were discussed at length. The Steering Committee had considered most of them earlier in the planning process. He pointed out an error on the Settlement Boundary map and will find out more about 'self-build' and 'custom-build' as they may be incorporated into the Plan. (ask Michael)

#### Other important changes:

The significant views on the Settlement Boundary Map (p.27) to be changed from arrows to 'fans' which will emphasise the views out. (inform Michael)

Sentence already added to H.09 "as will prominent views in to and out of Deppers Bridge".  
Footpaths within the village to be added. Linda will research an up-to-date map of them.  
The Scout Hut and Village of the Year Plaque were added to H.12 and H.19 respectively.

The meeting ended at 9.40pm. The next meeting will be after Stratford DC has responded.
